To Whom it may Concern,

Re: CORONAVIRUS

The School is following current official government advice, which can be found [here](#).

We would be grateful if any visitors to the School could follow this advice and not come into school if they have had close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the past 14 days, or if they are experiencing symptoms themselves.

Public Health England are now advising anyone to stay at home for 7 days, if they have either:

- A high temperature
- A new continuous cough

In addition, if anyone in a household has a persistent cough or fever, all members of that household must stay at home for 14 days.

We would be grateful if you would follow the above advice and not come into school if you fall into one of the above categories.
