St John's College School is looking for a Drama Graduate for a fixed term 2 year contract, to provide assistance in the Drama department, from September 2020. Working closely with the Head of Drama and the wider department, you will be working with children at all levels within the school, from the ages of 4 to 13.

You will assist with the daily running of lessons and rehearsals, teaching new warm up games and drama activities, participating in group storytelling and playing an active role in the department. You will be heavily involved with the many productions that take place during the year, assisting with all areas from casting to rehearsals, lighting, wardrobe and even set building. You will also carry out some administrative and general tasks, such as covering reception, photocopying, and supervising children in the playground during breaks.

The role would be particularly suited to someone looking to teach in the field of Drama, with a particular interest in helping young children develop their performance and communication skills. High levels of initiative and flexibility will be required, as due to performance and rehearsal schedules, the working hours may vary (although they should not exceed 40 hours per week). You will work term time (34 weeks per year), plus several days preceding and following each term, to prepare.
